Take Home Instructions for Temporary Bridge

You have had state-of-the-art appointment for a custom Bridge. The teeth were prepared and digital scans of the teeth were taken. They will be sent to the lab for fabrication. A temporary bridge was placed at this appointment to hold the teeth in position while the restoration is being made.

Use Caution Immediately after appointment

When an anesthetic has been used, your lips and tongue may be numb for several hours after the appointment.

Until the numbness has completely worn off, avoid:

- any chewing
- hot beverages

It is very easy to bite or burn your lip or tongue while you are numb.

If you have any prolonged numbness, inability to open and close, stiffness or pain in the jaw or any other symptoms you are unsure of please call us.

Here are some things you can do in the meantime:

- Take ibuprofen 400 mg every 4-6 hours as needed
- Hot or cold compress 10 minutes at a time, 3-4 times per day.
- Massage the area.
- Avoid hard, chewy foods.

To keep your Temporary Bridge in place:

- Avoid sticky foods such as gum, caramel, etc.
- Avoid hard foods such as nuts or peanut brittle
- Chew on the opposite side of your mouth.

It is important to brush normally. Daily flossing is very important but use caution. When flossing, don't pull up on the floss but pull the floss out from the side of the temporary crown.

Sensitivity

It is normal to experience some temperature and pressure sensitivity after each appointment. The sensitivity should subside a few weeks after the placement of the final restoration. Mild pain medications may also be used as directed by our office.

- Any swelling and/or discomfort in the area of the injection is common. If you experience this, please use a warm or cold compress, whichever one provides you better relief. Use the compress for 10 minutes 3 times per day.
- Please call our office if you experience any unusual discomfort.

If your bite feels uneven, if you have persistent pain, or if your temporary bridge comes off. **Call the office immediately at 925-689-2585** so we can re-cement it ASAP.
